OTHER FEES AND EXPENSES	
Personal school supplies (pencils, notebooks, crayons etc...). List provided by individual teachers before fall classes begin.	
Students participating in violin class will need to purchase or rent a violin. A violin costs approximately \$140 - \$160 new, about \$20/month to rent. Used violins are readily available in the \$100 range for youngest children.	
Enrollment - For new students only, non-refundable	\$150
Intent to Return - For returning students, annual fee deducted from first tuition payment at the beginning of the new school year	\$75
Navigators (3&4) - Three day field trip to Olympic Park Institute on Lake Crescent, Olympic National Park	\$200
Adventurers (5&6) - Covers two four-day field trips: one to Islandwood Outdoor Learning Center, Bainbridge Island, and one to a spring arts and environment camp with Centrum and Port Townsend Marine Science Center, Fort Worden. (Limited scholarships are available.)	\$750
Adventurers (5&6) - Technology Fee covers the cost of a netbook for the Adventurer 1:1 computer program. These netbooks become the property of the student when paid in full and may be taken with them as they graduate from Swan School. (A limited number of netbooks are set aside for those needing financial aid.)	\$550
Optional field trips or educational opportunities occasionally arise during the year that are outside our budget; in those cases, if you would like your child to participate there may be an additional fee added to your monthly tuition invoice.
