<sup>1</sup> The intent to return fee applies to returning students only. It holds the student's seat and will be applied to the first monthly installment tuition invoice of the 2017-2018 school year.

<sup>2</sup> The enrollment fee is a one time non-refundable charge that covers administrative costs at the time of initial enrollment.

<sup>3</sup> Swan School provides students with an arts and music program. To help defray the costs associated with these enrichment programs an \$80 fee is collected annually. You may opt to pay this fee in full at the beginning of the school year, or it can be prorated and added to your monthly tuition invoice.

<sup>4</sup> The extended trip fee covers the unique costs of extended multi-day trips for the Navigator and Adventurer programs (limited scholarships are available). Other field experiences are included in tuition.

<sup>5</sup> The Navigator trip fee includes a three day trip to NatureBridge (formally the Olympic Park Institute) on Lake Crescent in Olympic National Park and a one day field experience with CedarRoot Folk School. An optional payment plan for these trips can be arranged through the office.

<sup>6</sup> The Adventurer trip fee includes both a three-day fall trip and a week-long spring trip. Due to the variability of travel costs this fee is an approximation and is subject to change. An optional payment plan for these trips can be arranged through the office.

<sup>7</sup> Students in the Adventurers' class have listed on their supply list a laptop computer. Computers are integral to instruction with this age group. However, it is not necessary for students to have a new laptop, netbooks, tablets and used laptops are often adequate. It is important to check with the teacher about computer specifics to insure compatibility with the school's network and program. The amount listed in the chart is an average approximation and meant only for planning purposes, families are responsible for obtaining an appropriate computer for their child. There are a limited number of school owned netbooks set aside for those needing financial assistance.

<sup>8</sup> K-6 tuition can be paid in full prior to the first day of school or prepaid in 12 equal installments. Please see the Swan School Parent Handbook for specific policies regarding tuition, financial aid, and merit scholarships.
